St Mary's College Uniform

It is an expectation of the College that all students be in complete and correct uniform and present themselves in a clean, tidy and well-groomed manner. This expectation extends beyond the College grounds, as the representation of the College in the community is influenced by students wearing the full and correct uniform. Students are expected to come to and from school in the correct uniform.

Teachers will remind students of what is required should they not meet expectations. It is important that in the first instance, parents check daily that the uniform and personal appearance standards are being met. This partnership between home and College is important. This includes attention to the maintenance of uniforms in terms of wear and tear, freshness and size.

Our sun safety policy requires the wearing of hats whenever outdoors. Therefore, the wearing of hats with both the formal and sports uniform is a significant component of the College uniform.

For all Year Levels Monday and Wednesday is Formal Uniform, Tuesday and Thursday is students choice of Formal or Sports uniform. Friday is Formal, House or Sports Uniform

Hair

Hair must be kept neat, clean and tidy, away from the face

If hair touches the collar or covers the eyebrows it must be tied back with an appropriate hair tie.

Hair grooming, styling and colouring must be considerate of our College values. No extremes of style (including dreadlocks, mullets, tracks, shaved sections, bright hair dyes or shaved head under a no. 3) will be accepted, and hair colouring must be natural.

Students are expected to be clean shaven.

Footwear

Formal

College formal shoes must be black, leather, polishable, school shoes.

These shoes are not be flat soled, but should have a clearly defined sole and heel resembling a traditional school shoe. No runners, desert boots, suede, ballet type shoes, high tongues, platforms, high rollers, skate shoes, deck shoes, Converse, Vans or any other fashion canvas shoes are permitted.



Sport

The College insists on appropriate shoes which will provide adequate support and movement for physical activity. No runners, desert boots, suede, ballet type shoes, high tongues, platforms, high rollers, skate shoes, deck shoes, Converse, Vans or any other fashion canvas shoes are permitted. Students must wear formal shoes (regardless of uniform) for practical technology and Science classes ie. Food Technology, Design Technology and practical Science classes.

Jewellery and Make Up

Wrist watches, plain gold or silver ear studs or sleepers (one in each lower ear lobe only) may be worn. Hoop earrings are not permitted. No other facial or extra ear piercings should be visible.

Recognised discreet simple Christian religious symbols on a plain silver or gold chain may be worn inside the shirt or blouse. Other items of jewellery are not permitted.

No visible body piercing or tattooing is acceptable.

Body art or other body piercings must not be visible at any time in either formal or sports uniform, or casual clothes worn on 'free dress' days, camps or retreats.

Make Up

Tinted moisturiser or tinted sunscreen that are minimal are permitted. Make up and nail polish are not permitted. False eyelashes and nails are not permitted.
